wrapped up the month with the dedication of the 100 year 1st Infantry Division monument dedication in Victory Park. It was a beautiful day to officially unveil the commemorative monument that was donated to the Big Red One by the Historical and Archaeological Society of Fort Riley. September was momentous with our Pie Queens, Pam Quichocho and Maggy Gray, orchestrating the making and selling of 1,544 apple pies! With the help of 195 volunteers, the pies were made in record time in only 3 days (9 total shifts)! Big shout out to the coffee groups, KSU ROTC, the JC JROTC, post organizations, and community members that came out to the culinary lab to ensure the success of the apple pie making and volunteered in the sales tent on Apple Day. We have now seamlessly moved on to the annual Ghost Tours that will take place on Sunday, October 29th from 4-7:30pm. A new route is planned for this year that will feature some of the old favorites and share some new tales from buildings that have seen recent renovations, which seem to have disturbed their longest residents.  - Fast Passes will be available during Ghost Tours or you may purchase your pass online:




